Plans to set up a Shopmobility unit in Yeovil Town Centre are now moving ahead rapidly but generous support is needed from the business community to help make the vision a reality.

Several organisations have already pledged their financial support but more is needed and the Yeovil Shopmobility committee is launching a major fund-raising mission to keep the project on target in it's aim to open the scheme next Easter.
