"Preston Park play area was officially opened on Monday 13 December.

Local children can try out a new zip line along with other new equipment including a basket swing, agility trail, new roundabout and a tree house. Last year, students from Preston School visited the park to see how it could be improved and the designers took their views on board. Top on the childrens' list was a zip wire.

The £37,000 transformation has been made possible by funding from Yeovil Town Council, South Somerset District Council and the Wellbeing of Yeovil Community Association. It also benefitted from a health and wellbeing grant from county councillor Dave Greene and contributions from a local housing developer.

The improvements to the play area form part of the Town Councils rolling programme of play area refurbishments which ensure their facilities are kept in good order for the public to use and enjoy."
